

Vendor Contract

Third Monday Trade Days' liability insurance policy requires vendors to agree to the following three components.

One

As a participant in Third Monday Trade Days, vendors may not

- Sell guns
- Sell knives to underage shoppers
- Violate copyright and/or trademark laws
- Consume alcohol on market grounds
- Drive a vehicle on vending roads during market hours
- Lead a dog in the market or allow a dog near other vendors or shoppers
- Maintain their space in a way that is detrimental to market shoppers

Two

Certain vendors are required to purchase and maintain a minimum of \$1,000,000 of liability insurance and provide a Certificate of Insurance to the office. These vendors are those who:

- Operate carnival or pony rides, a market train, a petting zoo, or rent mobility carts
- Sell food and/or drink whether for consumption on-premises or elsewhere
- Sell CBD/hemp products, therapeutic treatments or supplements, or topical applications
- Sell dogs
- Operate power tools in the market

Three

Vendors who are not required to obtain liability insurance under Component Two, if they elect not to obtain liability insurance, must self-insure their market business and the products they sell on their vendor space since market liability insurance does not cover the operations of the vendor on his/her space.
